1- Canopy (B)






3- Wire Connectors (G)


# STEP 1: ASSEMBLE RODS

NOTE: Decide how low you would like the fixture to hang, then determine how many Long Rods (D) and Short Rod (E) you will need to make this length.

Connect Long Rods to top of Fixture Body (A) and Short Rod last, nearest the Canopy.



Do not twist fixture cord while turning these pieces together.




## STEP 2: ASSEMBLE MOUNTING HARDWARE

Thread the wires through the Canopy (B) and attach the Canopy (B) to the Short Rod (E), then screw the parts together.





#### STEP 3: ATTACH MOUNTING HARDWARE

Make sure the power is off, then secure the Mounting Bracket (C) to the Outlet Box with the Mounting Screws (H). Tighten until snug.










Prior to installation or removal of a previous fixture, disconnect power by turning off circuit breaker or removing fuse at electrical panel.

#### STEP 4: CONNECT ELECTRICAL

Trim wires leaving at least 12" to make electrical connection. Strip ends of 1/2" insulation. Attach bare (or green) ground wire from fixture to bare (or green) ground wire in junction box using Wire Connector (G). Wrap both around green ground screw on Mounting Bar (L) and firmly tighten.

TO AVOID ELECTRICAL SHOCK, WIRE FOR **CORRECT POLARITY:** Connect wires BLACK (or smooth) to BLACK. Connect wires WHITE (or ribbed along the edge) to WHITE. Firmly secure with Wire Connectors. SEE INSET BELOW:








# STEP 5: COVER JUNCTION BOX

Attach the Canopy (B) to the Mounting Bracket (C) by screwing on the Finials (F).








Prior to installation or removal of a previous fixture, disconnect power by turning off circuit breaker or removing fuse at electrical panel.

STEP 6: INSTALL SHADES (NOT INCLUDED)
Remove Finial (attached to Fixture Body (A)
just above Socket assembly) then slip Shade,
TOP FIRST, over Socket and slide center ring
over threaded nipple. Replace and tighten
Finial to secure Shade.

### STEP 7: INSTALL BULBS


Sockets on this Fixture rated up to 60 Watt Maximum Type A Bulbs.


\*LED bulbs may be used and permit a choice of brighter bulb without exceeding socket rating. To mimic the color of an incandescent, choose 2700K Soft White.


